Current:

Article V: OFFICERS

Section 1. Officers

- a. The elected officers shall be a Chairman, three Vice-Chairmen, and a Secretary. They shall assume their duties at the close of the biennial organizational meeting and shall serve a term of two years or until their successors are elected.

Recommended amendment:

Article V: OFFICERS

Section 1. Officers

- a. The elected officers shall be a Chairman, **First Vice Chairman, two additional Vice Chairmen**, and a Secretary. They shall assume their duties at the close of the biennial organizational meeting and shall serve a term of two years or until their successors are elected.

Rationale: The CRC has disallowed partial votes at SCC meeting; therefore, a differentiation among the Vice Chairmen is needed as it is the intention of these bylaws to give the First Vice Chairman the vote at SCC.

Add Amendment:

Section 2. Duties b. The First Vice Chairman shall have the vote at all SCC meetings.

Existing Section 2. Duties b. becomes c. c, becomes d. and d. becomes e.

Rationale: To define First Vice President as the voting member of the SCC.

Current:

Section 4. Vacancies

d. In the event of a vacancy in the office of any Vice-Chairman, the Chairman may appoint an acting Vice Chairman or acting Secretary to serve until the vacancy is filled by the BCR Vacancy Committee. The Secretary or the acting Secretary or his designee, as the case may be, shall send the call to all Vacancy Committee members within ten days of the vacancy. The vacancy shall be filled within thirty days of the call. Electronic notification to the most recently provided address shall suffice. Members may request in writing to be notified by mail.

Amendment:

Section 4. Vacancies

d. In the event of a vacancy in the office of any Vice-Chairman **or Secretary**, the Chairman may appoint an acting Vice Chairman or acting Secretary to serve until the vacancy is filled by the BCR Vacancy Committee. **Since the BCR Vacancy Committee is the Executive Committee, the Secretary shall in the Call for the next monthly Executive Committee Meeting include action to ratify the Chairman's interim appointment or to nominate and elect a replacement for the particular vacancy.**

Rationale: To state the methodology for filling vacancy of a Vice Chairman or Secretary.

Current:

ARTICLE VII: MEETINGS OF THE BCR

Section 1. The organization meeting of the BCR shall be held between February 1 and February 15 of odd numbered years.

- a. Its purpose shall be to:
 - 1. Hear reports of the Treasurer, the Financial Review Committee and all other standing and special committees.
 - 2. Elect a Chairman, three Vice-Chairmen, and a Secretary.

Amendment:

ARTICLE VII: MEETING OF THE BCR

- a. Its purpose shall be to:
 - 1. Hear reports of the Treasurer, Financial Review Committee, and all other standing and special committees.
 - 2. Elect a Chairman, First Vice Chairman, two additional Vice Chairmen, and a Secretary.

Rationale: To remove unnecessary word "the" and to specify addition of electing a specific First Vice Chairman and two additional Vice Chairmen.
