Chairman's Report:

Peg Cage said that Pat Nettleblad is moving and has resigned as Treasurer. She appointed Marty Neilson as Treasurer, Sara Synder as Financial Review Committee Chairman, and Charlotte Jacobsen as Lincoln Dinner Chairwoman

Vice Chairman Reports:

David Brown reported that we did not participate in the Unity in the Community event because they raised the cost to \$500 and that we are recording our meetings now.

Bob Reeves has been canvassing neighborhoods using Numinar which only covered Boulder County. He arranged it with the State GOP so that now have Numinar for Mead and all of Colorado. Bob and Dan O'Brein will have a training class on Numinar.

Greg Morrissey – talked about city council candidates.

Secretary's Report:

Cathy Jarrett reported that she continues to do the regular secretarial duties.

Treasurer's Report:

Pat Nettleblad is absent. Her report was read by Greg Morrissey. It stated that as of June 30, 2025, our total current cash assets were \$16,028.01. The May income was \$812.78, expenses were \$2498.89, and the net income was negative \$1,686.11. YTD (July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2025) our total income was \$36,510.05 and our total expenses were \$49,045.64 for a net income of negative \$12,535.59. As of July 22, 2025, our current cash assets are \$15,100.72. Peg Cage added that Basecamp, which we are no longer using, has refunded us \$1200.

District Captain Reports:

David Brown has nothing to report.

Charlie Danaher has been talking with Lid Clements about having a candidate forum at her church on October 7, 2025. He would interview the candidates and also write articles for the newspapers before and after the forum.

Bill DeOreo has been arguing with county clerk Molly Fitzgerald about the ballot box cameras. He may have a candidate for the Boulder city council.

David Murray has been watching the Louisville city council which wants to adopt the International Building Code which has hundreds of pages to control people. He also reported that Sandra Holloway set up a meeting with Democrats. They had no Democrats but only liberal unaffiliateds and Republicans.

Dan O'Brien has been reaching out to his PCPs. Four of seven responded.

Bob Reeves reported for **Kathy Reeves** that she is getting little response getting circulators for the Protect Kids Colorado petitions.

Committee Reports:

Finance Committee – Dick Murphy has no report.

Lincoln Dinner and Fundraising Committee met last Monday. The members are Dan O’Brein, Marty Neilson, Peg Cage and Mary Dodson. We need a good speaker. The goal is \$20,000 for which we need 300 people to attend.

Faith Based Advisor – Lid Clements reported that New Creation Church will announce the Save the Kids petitions. They will also have a forum again. Chris Martinez from Resurrection Church in Boulder has a presence on the CU campus. Joshua Peterson is with him.

Unfinished Business:

Bill DeOreao received a reply from the county clerk. We think that the cameras should view the face of the person inserting ballots and also the number of ballots they are inserting. Molly Fitzgerald does not think so. Bill has reserved space at the main Boulder city library for a meeting on September 22.
